Please read carefully the following ways art is accepted

1.) ADOBE PDF FILES

- A.) ALL ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE CROP MARKS
- **B.) PLEASE NO RGB FILES**
- C.) PLEASE NO CMYK FILES unless sending black files, then file must be Only Black, an example is: CMYK, (K = Black)
- D.) SPOT COLORS please use PANTONE uncoated or solid uncoated spot colors only, but use only 1 or the other not both
- E.) GRADIENTS must be either in Only Black or the Spot Color Used Only Black Files please use grayscale from (K) Black Only.
 - there can not be any colors mixed from RGB or CMYK to make black
 - Spot Color File please make sure all % of colors used to make the gradient are from the Spot Color
 - there can not be any % of colors mixed from RGB or CMYK when making the gradients
- F.) KNOCK-OUTS & OVERPRINTS are set correctly.
- G.) SCANNED COPIES OF LIVE SAMPLES Make sure all 4 corners of document are seen when then making .pdf when sent to us.

2.) EPS FILES

- A.) Must be made transparent & use PANTONE solid uncoated spot colors as above, when there is a background color/pantograph behind art or there will be a white box around the logo or object
- B.) There can not be any colors mixed from RGB or CMYK they have to be made from the Spot Color used or Black Only when creating the gradients
- C.) Please make sure all Knock-outs & Overprints are set correctly.

3.) FONTS

- A.) All fonts should be included with the art files or
- B.) Fonts might have to be turned into outlined type or
- C.) Font substitution may occur
